


Spring 2 - Year 1



Communication, Language & Literacy

We will be using 'The Curious Case of the Missing Mammoth'. The children will be writing a short story of their own based a similar theme to the story. We will continue to focus upon capital letters, finger spaces and full stops, as well developing our use of adjectives, conjunctions and many different forms of punctuation.

Problem Solving & Reasoning

Maths

The children will continue to focus on numbers and number bonds to 40. After that, they will look at money, length, height, volume, capacity and mass.

Creative Development

PE

This half term, our PE topic will be Net and Wall Game Skills and Dance with a focus on the Fire of London.

Music

The children will be focusing on the genre of Blues Latin music. We will learn the song 'Round & Round' as part of our musical journey this half term. We will also begin to practice our songs for the up-coming Infant Music festival.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

PSHE

Our PHSE topics will be 'Healthy Me' as well as focusing on 'Friendship' and other ELSA related areas of work.

RE

The children will focus on Islam and attempt to answer the question, 'How might beliefs about creation affect the way people treat our World?'

Creative Development

Science

We will continue to focus on 'Animals including Humans'. The children will also learn about what changes around us at the end of Winter, through Spring and the coming Summer months, through our Seasonal Change topic.

History

This term, we will be studying Queen Victoria & Queen Elizabeth I. The children will compare both their lives & the impact they had on the World.

Geography

This term, the children will attempt to answer the question 'Why is London our Capital City? The class will then look at the UK, specifically London and compare it to Weston/Runcorn.

Computing

This half term, we will continue to learn about E-Safety and how to communicate sensibly, how to access and navigate the internet and Seesaw. We will also control robots and describe technology used beyond school.

Art

This term, the children will complete a sculpting unit inspired by the work of Louise Bourgeois.

DT

This term, we will be focusing on mechanics. The children will then design and construct their own Vehicles and evaluate them.
